

1983 Scrabble® brand Sentence Cube Game Word Distribution

This table contains the word distribution for the 27-cube 1983 version of the game. The 21 cubes in the 1971 game do not appear to be a subset of these, though there do appear to be some dice in common between the two.

Each row in the table corresponds to a single die. I have made no attempt to present the dice or the words on each die in any particular order. Because of the font used to stamp the dice, it's impossible to tell the difference between NO and ON, so both alternatives are given for the two dice that contain that letter combination.† The two rows of asterisks represent the two wild dice, each of which has a star on every face.
